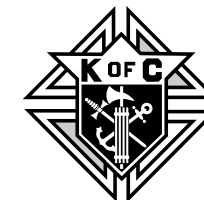

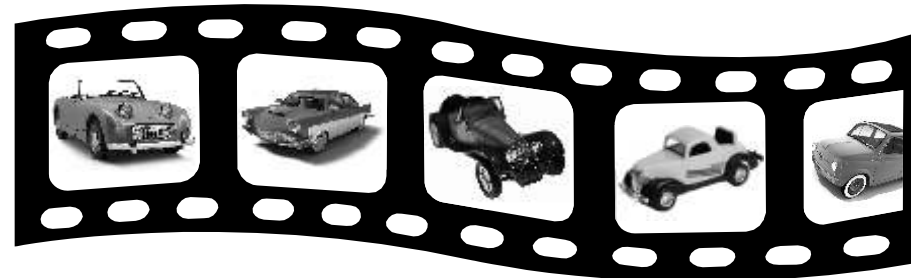

Fr. Edward Kelty

sisters, and therefore, to the whole nation. The perennial discipline of the Church, for that reason among other reasons, has prohibited the giving of Holy Communion and the granting of a Church funeral to those who persist, after admonition, in the grave violation of the moral law . . .

The person in question bears a heavy responsibility for the grave scandal which he has caused. The responsibility is especially heavy for political leaders. The repair of such scandal begins with the public acknowledgment of his own error and the public declaration of his adherence to the moral law."

**COUNCIL BYLAW CHANGE
ON DUES PAYMENTS
IS PROPOSED**

Where as: During the transition of financial secretaries it was brought to light that dues can be collected by the calendar year or financial year.

Where as: The Grand Knight submits an annual budget that runs from July 1 to June 30 and the vast amount of money collected doesn't come in until, November to March.

Whereas: The Supreme council sets the per capatia roster in October members in errs at the end of a calendar year can not be suspended until July, there by incurring additional loses in income will being charge for the per capatia.. If they were suspended in July through September the council would not incur this charge in the next year and would not have to send additional notices to said members.

Be it resolved: That we change our bylaws (Article I GENERAL sec. 3) to read "Each member shall pay annual dues or the same quarterly in advance at the first regular meeting in July October January April. The annual dues of members shall be \$45.00. If paid by September 15, they shall be \$40.00. (A \$5.00 discount) The annual dues of honorary members shall be the Supreme per capita, and State per capita, and any other supreme or State charges that might be access to the council for these members. Honorary life members are exempt from paying any council dues."

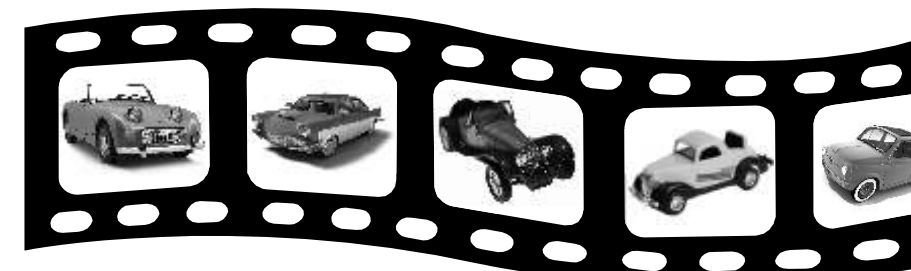
